The elements will be assessed through a variety of selection tasks and through observation e.g. Foundation Course/Attendance at day 1 of Spring Seminar.

Professionalism	 ★ Able to work fairly, impartially, and respectfully in a team environment. ★ Respond to requests for information in a timely manner to meet deadlines. ★ Dress professionally when carrying out judging duties.
